Key Stage 2 to 4 data 2019

96% of students who completed full time Key stage 4 places in school achieved functional skills English, maths and ICT. 2 students achieved this at Level 1 or above.

All students on roll achieved an externally recognised English and Maths qualification (GCSE, Level 1 or entry level).

Average calculated points score (scoring GCSE, Level 1 and entry level qualifications) showed a decrease on the previous year as a significant number of the cohort have severe learning difficulties.

There were 32 students in the Year 11 cohort finishing Key Stage 4 in June 2019.
 22 were taught in the main body of the school.
 2 students were on full time AEP placements
 2 students were on part time AEP placements
 6 students were in our Base provision. This has a focus on life skills and functionality.

12 students left Bank View at the end of year 11 and went onto college courses.
 13 students went onto Bank View 6th form.
 5 students are completing a 6th form place in Base 2.
 1 student is completing day a week in school and 4 days volunteering
 1 student has begun a supported internship placement in the 6th form.

 On completing year 11 placements 9 of these students were able to travel independently.

All the students in the base provision (6 students) achieved at least 8 entry level qualifications. These included life skills units.

Bank View data compares very favourably with like schools locally and nationally
