





On Thursday 24th August many of our year 11 students came into school to collect their GCSE and entry level results. We have had another very successful year and we are extremely proud of our student's results and the efforts they put in and the barriers they overcame to achieve a broad range of qualifications.





This year we had 41 students completing year 11.

30 were in the main provision of the school following a secondary curriculum with subject specialist teachers. 8 students were in our base provision which caters for our most complex students. 3 attended Alternative Provision.

Main Secondary Provision



GCSEs

7 students achieved a GCSE grade in 5 or more subjects including English and Maths.

English and Maths

All students accessing the main secondary provision achieved an English and maths qualification at entry level.

10 students sat and achieved a GCSE grade in English language.

All students achieved an entry level.

28 students achieved a functional skills English qualification at entry level

24 students sat GCSE Maths, 21 achieved a GCSE grade

All students achieved an entry level
5 students achieved a functional skills maths qualification at level 1
29 students achieved a functional skills maths qualification at entry level





Science

All students achieved a science qualification.

9 were entered for and achieved a double GCSE grade in Science Triology, including 3 students who achieved 4:4s.

21 achieved double award entry level science

Computing/IT Functional Skills

All students achieved functional skills IT or entry level computing units

3 students achieved functional skills ICT at level 1

5 students achieved functional skills maths at level 1

Art

All students achieved a GCSE qualification in Art and Design. Of these 43% were a grade four or above.

Food Nutrition, Graphics and DT

6 students achieved a GCSE in Food and Nutrition. 23 students achieved a Creative Media entry level.

PΕ

All students achieved an entry level in PE.

Options

Through their option choices students achieved entry level, level 1 and level 2 in subjects including MFL (Spanish), Sports Leadership, Performing Arts, Home Cooking, Construction, Humanities (including World Views) and Preparing for the World of Work (Childcare).

Base Provision

Students completed a Further Learning for Employment and Living in the Community Qualification at either entry level 1 or 2. The qualification is designed to cover communication and interaction, life and independence skills and art.

In addition:

- 5 students achieved an entry level maths qualification,
- 3 students achieved an entry level English qualification
- 3 students achieved both maths and English
- 5 students achieved in single ward

Functional Skills

- 5 students achieved an entry level in maths
- 1 student achieved an entry level in English
- 4 students achieved in ICT

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1 student achieved maths and English functional skills at EL3 entry level 3 and units in vocational subjects at entry level

1 student who an online tuition offer achieved maths functional skills at EL3 and the reading and writing strands of the functional skills EL3 English

1 student achieved three Level 1 BTEC qualifications with a vocational emphasis in art, science and construction.
