We will be looking closely at changes that occur as summer leaves us and autumn arrives.</p> <p>We will be using Emotion Pebbles to talk about how we feel in different circumstances, before ending our topic with a party to celebrate all the things we are good at and what makes us unique.</p>	<p>Focusing on the hero in all of us; is a fun topic that focuses on ourselves, our families, superhero animals, superhero vehicles, the super real-life heroes and fictional heroes. We will look at Florence Nightingale and how nursing has changed from the past to how we know nursing today, as well as look at other famous historical superheroes. As a class, we will share who is important to us. We will explain why we love these people so much and what makes them so special.</p>	<p>'Fire, Fire!' We will be learning about significant historical events from the 17th Century 'The Great Fire of London' and comparing it with how our emergency services fight fires today; we even have a trip to the fire station planned. Then we will study the buildings of the period and create our own buildings. Then off we go to learn about all of the famous London landmarks. We will put on our best outfits because we are invited to afternoon tea with the Queen!</p>

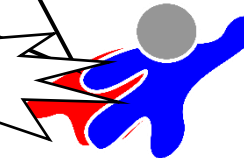
