<p>Our year 9 classes will be finishing their topic on health. They have covered different diseases and looking at the methods the body uses to protect itself.</p> <p>They will be moving on to study electricity. They will be creating circuits as well as looking at how electricity is supplied to the home.</p>	<p>We will be working on a business enterprise project, learning about product development and marketing. Learners will be introduced to using Cricut design space software and we will develop plans for a range of products to be customised.
